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History

- The Institution was originally founded as a Bible College in May 1978 by the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada (PAOC).
- It was then known as Pan Africa Christian College.
- The inaugural classes took place on May 2, 1978, with six students.



History Contd...

- The College was awarded a university charter in February 2008 by the late President Mwai Kibaki.
- Its name changed to Pan Africa Christian University, making it the first PAOC University in the world.
